## In Scripture Today

### Matthew 16:21-28

Reading through Matthew we glimpse some of the struggles about leadership in the early Christian community, for although last week Matthew accorded Peter authority in the early Christian community, this second half of the episode tells of Jesus chastising Peter for forgetting that the Christian life leads to the cross. The Rock is now Satan. Matthew writes believing that the end of the world is imminent. The Son of Man, an eschatological figure who hovers between God and the human race, will come to judge the world. Thus believers need no longer live for this world.

### Jeremiah 15:15-21

Jeremiah lived during a turbulent time of continuous warfare in the Middle East. Speaking and writing the words of God between 626 bce and 586 bce, Jeremiah announced that the evil people were suffering was punishment because of their unfaithfulness to God. The idea is that since only God has such power, God must be the just source of such sorrow. For this unpopular position, Jeremiah was continuously

opposed. In the poem of 15:15-21, Jeremiah complains about how he is treated, but he trusts in God's promises, and he "eats" God's word with joy. Once again, the believer hears from God, "I am with you."

**Romans 12:9-21**

Writing to the church in Rome, Paul makes clear that Christians should attend in love to each other and work to alleviate the sufferings of others, never adding to human misery by acts of reprisals. Christians continue the work of Christ by overcoming evil with good.
